

#### St. Ignatius in 1888!

Any thanks to Dick Leitsch, Archivist of the Church of St. Mary the Virgin, for sending us a link to an article that appeared in the June 1888 issue of *Harper's Weekly Magazine*, entitled "Surpliced Choirs in New York." The article gives a wonderful glimpse into the church music scene of the late 19th century and the controversy over employing vestments as well as women in church choirs. As the organist of St. Mary's at that time argued, "I find that a few ladies give a certain finish to the tone, especially to the high notes, which cannot be obtained from boys alone." There is also this marvelous picture in the old church, showing Fr. Ritchie and our own surpliced choir in procession around 1888.
